*The week of May 12-17 was National Nursing Home Week and we had a great time with our residents, families and staff. The theme was "Living the Aloha Spirit" and we were not short on ideas. One day featured a Tropical Carry-in that included a staff competition for best dish. There were many tasty treats that we all enjoyed. Everyone voted on the dish he enjoyed the most. The winning dish was Old Fashioned Coconut Cream Pie made by Charolette Alsept!*

*Try the recipe out for yourself and let us know what you think.*

### Old Fashioned Coconut Cream Pie

1 cup Sugar or equivalent amount of Splenda  
¼ cup Flour  
Dash of Salt  
3 Egg Yolks or egg substitute  
2 cups Milk or same amount of fat-free half & half  
1½ tsp. Vanilla Extract  
1¼ cup Flaked Coconut, toasted lightly - Divide  
One 9" pie shell, baked or use a Keebler reduced fat graham cracker crust

#### Directions:

In a large sauce pan, combine flour, sugar and salt. Combine egg yolks and milk. Stir in the dry ingredients until smooth. Cook and stir over medium heat until mixture is thickened and bubbly. Reduce heat to low; cook and stir 2 minutes longer. Remove from heat; stir in vanilla and 1 cup coconut. Pour hot filling into pie shell. For meringue, beat egg whites in a bowl until soft peaks form. Gradually beat in 6 teaspoons of sugar until mixture forms stiff, glossy peaks. Spread meringue over hot filling, sprinkle with remaining coconut. Bake at 350 degrees for 12-15 minutes or until golden brown. Yields 8 servings.

# Rehab & Home

## *How Long Does it Take to Recover from Total Hip Replacement?*

Most patients undergoing total hip replacement surgery want to know when they'll be able to return to their normal life. There are many factors that can contribute to recovery time, but typically patients can return to normal life activities within 1 to 6 months.

Short-term recovery involves the early stages of recovery, such as the ability to get out of the hospital bed and be discharged from the hospital. On days one or two, most total hip replacement patients are given a walker to stabilize them. By the third day after the surgery, most patients can go home or to a rehab facility such as Lincoln Park Manor. Making prior arrangements for your stay will assure that all treatment and therapy will start as soon as you arrive.

It is also important to know that proper wound care is vital as you will most likely have staples or stitches. Lincoln Park Manor provides a dedicated Wound



Care Nurse who monitors for infection and proactive solutions when patients are healing from any open wound. She has been a part of our staff for many years and area physicians recommend our facility due in part to this close monitoring and confidence that a patient can have the opportunity to get home faster.

Patients who see physical therapy as an integral part of their recovery tend to return to their normal activities more quickly. The goals of physical therapy are to prevent contractures, improve patient education, and strengthen muscles around the hip joint through controlled exercises. Contractures are a condition of shortening and hardening of muscles, tendons or other tissue, often leading to deformity and rigidity of joints. Contractures can cause limitation of full joint motion. Our team of occupational and physical rehab experts will help you get back to your life as quickly as possible.

Senior Independence and Home Instead, One Lincoln Park offers residents a variety of options that allow them to remain independent.

Headed up by Angie Smith, RN and Wellness Coordinator at One Lincoln Park, Senior Independence assists our residents with basic health concerns such as blood pressure monitoring all the way through responding to medical emergencies. Since they are Medicare-certified, they can provide skilled nursing and therapy services in the apartments. Their aides will also address many other privately paid in-

identicals from putting on elastic hose to medication reminders. Assistance can be booked with Senior Independence for as little as 15 minutes a day. Senior Independence also staffs our on-site Wellness Clinic every weekday morning.

Home Instead offers another dimension of assistance. Their aides provide help with daily living activities such as personal care. They can also provide up to 24 hour companionship services. Combined, these two agencies allow our residents to experience longer and happier lives here at One Lincoln Park.

Residents who are already established with other home health agencies are welcome to use the service provider they prefer.
