Did you know that Lincoln Park Manor offers extensive rehabilitation services?



Typical stays are driven by elective surgeries for hip and knee replacements and most patients are discharged after less than a three week stay.

Many who are planning these procedures, and I'll share they are getting younger and younger with most in their 50's, contact us before they have their surgery to get pre-registered and let us know what services they prefer during their stay. "We cater to your needs as much as possible when you stay with us for any type of condition," said Ann Wittoesch, Admissions Director. For instance if you prefer to sleep in or have your shower at a certain time, we will try to schedule therapy later in the day. If you would like a newspaper everyday and room service for your meals, all of those preferences are documented in advance. Pre-planning allows us to get your insurance information and approvals, doctor and family contact information and have a room waiting for you.

We have rooms available and can admit patients anytime day or night. Emergency room visits and discharges from the hospital are acted on promptly, however when possible, it makes it a little smoother if you can plan in advance.

In fact, therapy services make up over 63% of their skilled nursing area. "It's always been a focus for our business and the community really needs to think of us, not just as a nursing home, but as a medically diverse establishment," explained Dr. Heckman, Medical Director.

We've come a long way from the "old school" ways that most nursing homes used to operate on. There were more acute, long term care patients years ago than what there are today. People stay in their homes longer and are living longer.

Over the past ten years or so, Lincoln Park Manor has transitioned into more therapy driven services that meet the needs of today's seniors, as well as specialty therapies like our Congestive Heart Failure (CHF) program.

Our goal is to get you home as quickly as possible so that you can return to your daily life.

These short REHAB stays are the reason many turn to us for their care.

Q: "My mother has dementia and is starting to require more care and supervision. What types of care and living situations are available for her at Lincoln Park Manor? How is the cost structured (upfront fees, monthly fees, optional services)? Is there any guest housing available on-site?"

A: Lincoln Park Manor can accommodate early stage dementia patients that are not a wandering risk. Our nursing staff is very attentive and can work with you closely for immediate and long term care needs.

Fees are monthly and billed to your insurance for the amount of coverage you have available. We can do a no charge analysis to determine what coverage you have available. If no insurance, then private pay arrangements will be discussed. Guest housing may be available, call for details.



Why the increase in knee & hip replacements?

The boomers who tend to forget their body's age while exercising or playing too rigorously, too often, may end up damaging hip and knee joints in particular and have spurred a new term "boomeritis" in the orthopedic industry.

It's the condition with which many middle-aged patients become afflicted with when they've overstressed their aging body parts to the point of requiring drastic treatments. A few of the maladies diagnosed in association with boomeritis include tendinitis, bursitis, and arthritis—all conditions further exacerbated by continued activity if left untreated.

Osteoarthritis, or degenerative joint disease, can be particularly debilitating and often requires replacement surgery. Until now, both knee and hip replacement surgeries used to be primarily associated with the Medicare population.

That's changing with boomeritis on the rise, according to an article by Dr. Matthew Boes, a Raleigh, N.C., sports medicine specialist. Over the last 10 years

he says there was a threefold increase in knee replacements among the 45- to 64-year-old age span.

The rise in replacement surgery among boomers is this: Knee arthritis can be extremely debilitating and interfere with even the basic activities of daily living. Rather than suffer with knee pain, baby boomers realize that a knee replacement typically relieves pain and facilitates a return to a healthy, active lifestyle.

Hip replacement procedures have been found to result in significant restoration of function and reduction of pain in over 90 percent of patients.

Lincoln Park Manor's REHAB CENTER has experienced a significant increase in treating joint replacement patients after surgery.

What is independent living?

In general, the housing is friendlier to older adults, often being more compact, with easier navigation and no maintenance or yard work to worry about. One Lincoln Park offers 250 luxury apartment homes located all in one building.

While residents live independently, most communities offer amenities, activities, and services. Often, recreational centers or clubhouses are available on site to give seniors the opportunity to connect with peers and participate in community activities, such as arts and crafts, holiday gatherings, continuing education classes, or movie nights. One Lincoln Park's transportation department is a unique amenity. Residents can access chauffeured transportation 7 days a week and use it as often as they like at no additional charge.


